Eight Steps to Deliverance

- 1. Honesty & Acknowledgement ask God to help you see yourself as He sees you
 - "Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me, and know my anxieties; And see if there is any wicked way in me, And lead me in the way everlasting." (Psalm 139:23-24)
 - "I acknowledge my sin to You, and my iniquity I have not hidden. I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD," and You forgave the iniquity of my sin." (Psalm 32:5)

2. Humility & Confession

- "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble." (James 4:6)
- "Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed." (James 5:16)

3. Repentance (Godly Sorrow)

- Now I rejoice, not that you were made sorry, but that your sorrow led to repentance. For you were made sorry in a godly manner, that you might suffer loss from us in nothing. ¹⁰For godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death." (2Corinthians 7:9-10)
- 4. **Renunciation** verbally rejecting & forsaking evil
 - "Therefore say to the house of Israel, 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says: Repent! Turn from your idols and renounce all your detestable practices! (Ezekiel 14:6 NIV)
- **5.** Forgiveness of others, of God, of self
 - "For **if you forgive** men their trespasses, **your heavenly Father will also forgive you**. ¹⁵But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses." (Matthew 6:14-15)
 - **Forgiveness leads to deliverance** and **lack of forgiveness to oppression**, as shown in the parable in Matthew 18:23-35
- 6. **Prayer** toward God
 - "Whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be delivered." (Joel 2:32, KJV)
 - "Submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you." (James 4:7)

7. Warfare – toward Satan

- "Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you." (Luke 10:19)
- "And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons." (Mark 16:17)
- "I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven." (Matthew 16:19)
- 8. **Praise** to God for setting you free (Psalm 107:21-22)
 - Then they **cried out to the LORD** in their trouble, and **He saved them** out of their distresses. He sent His word and **healed them**, and **delivered them** from their destructions.
 - Oh, that men would give thanks to the LORD for His goodness, And for His wonderful works to the children of men! Let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare His works with rejoicing.
