HEALING SCRIPTURES

Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be **healed**. (Jeremiah 17:14)

He Himself took our **infirmities** and bore our **sicknesses**. (Matthew 8:17)

He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and **by His stripes we are healed**. (Isaiah 42:5, 1Peter 2:24)

And these **signs** will follow **those who believe...** they will **lay hands on the sick**, and they **will recover**. (Mark 16:17-18)

And the **prayer of faith** will **save the sick**, and the Lord will **raise him up**. And if he has committed sins, **he will be forgiven**. (James 5:15)

And **whatever you ask** in **My name**, that **I will do**, that the **Father may be glorified** in the Son. (John 14:13)

INNER HEALING

Surely He has borne our **griefs** and carried our **sorrows**. (Isaiah 53:4)

The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me, because the LORD has anointed Me to preach **good tidings to the poor**; He has sent Me to **heal the brokenhearted**, to **proclaim liberty** to the **captives**, and the opening of the prison to those who are **bound...** to **comfort** all who mourn, to **console** those who mourn in Zion, to give them **beauty for ashes**, the **oil of joy** for **mourning**, the **garment of praise** for the **spirit of heaviness**. (Isaiah 61:1-3)

Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, **casting all your care upon Him**, for **He cares for you**. (1Peter 5:7)

HEALING THE MIND

Do not be conformed to this world, but be **transformed** by the **renewing of your mind**, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God. (Rom. 12:2)

Put off, concerning your former conduct, the **old man** which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, and be **renewed in the spirit of your mind**, and that you put on the **new man** which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness. (Ephesians 4:22-24)

For the **weapons** of our **warfare** are not carnal but **mighty in God** for pulling down **strongholds**, casting down **arguments** and every high thing that **exalts itself** against the **knowledge of God**, bringing every **thought** into **captivity** to the **obedience** of Christ. (2Corinthians 10:4-5)

MIND/BODY RELATIONSHIP

A **merry heart** doeth **good** like a **medicine**: but a **broken spirit** drieth the **bones**.
(Proverbs 17:22)

Pleasant words are as an honeycomb, **sweet to the soul**, and **health to the bones**.
(Proverbs 16:24)

A **sound heart** is the **life** of the **flesh**; but **envy** is the **rottenness** of the **bones**. (Proverbs 14:30)

Hope deferred makes the **heart sick**, but when the desire comes, it (hope) is the **tree of life**. (Proverbs 13:12)

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of **peace** and **not of evil**, to give you a **future** and a **hope**. (Jeremiah 29:11)

This **hope** we have as an **anchor of the soul**, both **sure** and **steadfast**. (Hebrews 6:19)

FEAR/WORRY

Therefore **do not worry**, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?'... For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. But **seek first the kingdom of God** and His righteousness, and **all these things shall be added to you**. (Matthew 31-33)

For **God** has **not given** us a **spirit of fear**, but of **power** and of **love** and of a **sound mind**. (2Timothy 1:7)

There is **no fear** in **love**; but **perfect love casts out fear**, because **fear** involves **torment**. (1John 4:18)

In **God** I have put my **trust**; I will **not be afraid**. What can **man do to me**? (Psalm 56:11)

And **do not fear** those who **kill the body** but **cannot kill the soul**. But rather **fear Him** who is able to **destroy both soul and body in hell**. (Matthew 10:28)

LOOK AHEAD, NOT BEHIND

Forgetting those things which are **behind** and **reaching forward** to those things which are **ahead**, I **press toward the goal** for the **prize** of the **upward call** of God in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 3:13-14)

Let us **lay aside every weight** and the **sin** which so **easily ensnares us**, and let us **run** with **endurance** the **race** that is set **before us**. (Hebrews 12:1)

DEALING WITH TRIALS & TRIBULATIONS

Count it all **joy** when you fall into **various trials**, knowing that the **testing of your faith** produces **patience**. But let patience have its **perfect work**, that you may **be perfect and complete, lacking nothing**. (James 1:2-4)

Beloved, do not think it **strange** concerning the **fiery trial** which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened to you; but **rejoice** to the extent that you **partake of Christ's sufferings**, that when His glory is revealed, you may also **be glad with exceeding joy**. (1Peter 4:12-13)

FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT

But the **fruit of the Spirit** is **love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control.** (Galatians 5:22-23)

LOVE

Though I speak with the tongues of men and angels, but **have not love**, I have become **sounding brass** or a **clanging cymbal**. And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but **have not love, I am nothing**. And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor; and though I give my body to be burned, but **have not love**, it **profits me nothing**. (1Corinthians 13:1-3)

Love is patient, love is **kind**. It does **not envy**, it does **not boast**, it is **not proud**. It is **not rude**, it is **not self-seeking**, it is **not easily angered**, it keeps **no record of wrongs**. **Love does not delight in evil** but **rejoices** with the **truth**. It always **protects**, always **trusts**, always **hopes**, always **perseveres**. **Love never fails**. (1Corinthians 13:4-9)

Neither **death nor life**, nor **angels** nor **principalities**, nor **powers**, nor things **present** nor **things to come**, nor **height** nor **depth**, nor any other **created thing**, shall be able to **separate us** from the **love of God** which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 8:38-39)

You shall **love the Lord your God** with all your **heart**, with all your **soul**, with all your **mind**, and with all your **strength**. This is the first commandment. And the second, like it, is this: You shall **love your neighbor as yourself**. There is no other commandment greater than these. (Mark 12:30-31)

I (Jesus) say to you who hear: **Love your enemies**, do **good** to those who **hate you**, **bless** those who **curse you** and **pray** for those who **spitefully use you**. (Luke 6:27-28)

THE JOY OF THE LORD

In **Your Presence** is **fullness of joy**; at **Your right hand** are **pleasures forevermore**. (Psalm 16:11)

For His **anger** is but for **a moment**, His **favor** is for life; **weeping** may endure for a **night**, but **joy** comes in the **morning**.

THE PEACE OF GOD

You will keep him in **perfect peace**, whose **mind is stayed on You**, because he trusts in You. **Trust in the LORD** forever, for in YAH, the LORD, is **everlasting strength**. (Isaiah 26:3)

And the **peace of God**, which **surpasses all understanding**, will **guard your hearts and minds** through Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:7)

THE PROMISES OF GOD

For **all the promises of God** in Him (Jesus) are **Yea**, and in Him, **Amen**. (2Corinthians 1:20)

The Lord is **not slack** concerning **His promise**, as some count slackness, but is **longsuffering toward us**, not willing that **any should perish**, but that **all** should come to **repentance**. (2Peter 3:9)

For you have need of **endurance**, so that after you have **done the will of God**, you may **receive the promise**. (Hebrews 10:36)

And this is the **promise** that He has promised us – **eternal life**. (1John 2:25)

He Himself (Jesus) has said, “I will **never leave you nor forsake you**.” So we may boldly say: “The **Lord is my helper, I will not fear**. What can man do to me?” (Hebrews 13:5-6)

He who **dwells** in the **secret place** of the **Most High**, shall **abide** under the **shadow of the Almighty**... a thousand may fall at your side, and ten thousand at your right had; but it **shall not come near you**... **no evil** shall befall you, **nor** shall any **plague** come near your **dwelling**. (Psalm 91:1,7,10)

And we know that **all things work together for good** to those who **love God**, to those who are the **called** according to **His purpose**. (Romans 8:28)

Now to **Him** who is **able** to do **exceedingly abundantly** above all that we **ask or think**, according to the **power that works in us**, to Him be **glory** in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen (Ephesians 3:20-21).

TRUST IN THE LORD

As for **God, His way is perfect**; the **word** of the Lord is **proven**; He is a **shield** to all who **trust** in Him. (2Samuel 22:31)

But let all those **rejoice** who put their **trust in You**; let them ever **shout for joy**, because **You defend them**. (Psalm 5:11)

The **Lord** is my **rock** and my **fortress** and my **deliverer**; my **God**, my **strength** in whom I will **trust**. (Psalm 18:2)

And the **Lord** shall **help them** and **deliver them**; He shall **deliver them** from the **wicked**, and **save them**, because they **trust in Him**. (Psalm 37:40)

SPEAK BLESSINGS, NOT CURSES

Death and life are in the **power** of the **tongue**. (Proverbs 18:21)

I (God) have set before you **life and death, blessing and cursing**. (Deuteronomy 30:19)

He who has a **perverse tongue**, falls into **evil**. (Proverbs 17:20)

The **tongue** is a **fire**, a world of **iniquity**. The **tongue** is so set among our members that it **defiles the whole body** and sets on fire the course of nature; and it is **set on fire by hell**. (James 3:6)

SPIRITUAL STRENGTH

Do **not sorrow**, for the **joy of the Lord** is your **strength**. (Nehemiah 8:10)

But those who **wait on the LORD** shall **renew their strength**; they shall **mount up with wings like eagles**, they shall **run and not be weary**, they shall **walk and not faint**. (Isaiah 40:31)

I can do all things through **Christ** who **strengthens me**. (Philippians 4:13)

My **grace** is **sufficient** for you, for **My strength** is made **perfect in weakness**. (2Corinthians 12:9)

JUDGMENTS

Judge not that you **be not judged**. For with what **judgments** you judge, **you will be judged**; and with the **measure you use**, it will be **measured back to you**. (Matthew 7:2)

Therefore you are **inexcusable**, O man, whoever you are **who judge**, for in **whatever you judge another**, you **condemn yourself**; (Romans 2:1)

FORGIVENESS/MERCY

If we **confess our sins**, He is **faithful** and **just to forgive** us our **sins** and to **cleanse** us from all **unrighteousness**. If we say that we **have not sinned**, we make Him a **liar**, and His Word is not in us. (1John 1:9-10)

For **if you forgive** men their trespasses, your **heavenly Father** will **also forgive you**. But **if you do not forgive** men their trespasses, **neither will your Father forgive** your trespasses. (Matthew 6:14-15)

Through the **LORD's mercies** we are **not consumed**, because **His compassions fail not**. They are **new every morning**; **great is Your faithfulness**. (Lamentations 3:22-23)

SALVATION

Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is **born again**, he cannot see the kingdom of God... unless one is **born of water** and the **Spirit**, he **cannot enter the kingdom of God**. That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is **born of the Spirit is spirit**." (John 3:3, 5-6)

For **God so loved the world** that He **gave His only begotten Son**, that **whoever believes** in Him should **not perish** but have **everlasting life**. (John 3:16)

For by **grace** you have been **saved** through **faith**, and that **not of yourselves**; it is the **gift of God**, **not of works**, lest anyone should boast. (Ephesians 2:8-9)

AUTHORITY/POWER

And **Jesus** came and spoke to them, saying, "**All authority** has been given to **Me** in **heaven** and on **earth**. (Matthew 28:18)

I (Jesus) am **He who lives**, and **was dead**, and behold, I am **alive forevermore**. Amen. And **I have the keys** of **Hades** and of **Death**. (Revelation 1:18)

On this rock I will build **My church**, and the **gates of Hades** shall **not prevail** against it. And **I will give you the keys** of the **kingdom of heaven**, and **whatever you bind on earth** will be **bound in heaven**, and **whatever you loose on earth** will be **loosed in heaven**. (Matthew 16:18-19)

Behold, I give you the **authority to trample on serpents and scorpions**, and **over all the power** of the **enemy**, and **nothing** shall by any means **hurt you**. (Luke 10:19)

And these **signs** will follow **those who believe**: In My name they will **cast out demons**; they will speak with new tongues; they will **take up serpents**; and if they drink anything deadly, it will **by no means hurt them**." (Mark 16:17-18)

Therefore **submit to God**. **Resist the devil** and **he will flee** from you. **Draw near to God** and **He will draw near to you**. (James 4:7-8)

And they **overcame** him (i.e. Satan) by the **blood of the Lamb** (i.e. Jesus) and by the word of their **testimony**, and they **did not love their lives** to the **death**. (Revelation 12:11)
